# What Dubuque County Democrats Stand For

Our mission is to establish and protect the human rights of all members of society, and create opportunity for a decent standard of living for everyone. We must never lose sight that everyone deserves a clean, sustainable, energy-efficient environment as well as safe and nutritious food and water. In addition, people need necessary clothing, adequate housing, high-quality affordable medical care, necessary social services, and the right to security in the event of circumstances beyond their control. These circumstances could be but are not limited to international conflict, natural disaster, disease, disability, death of significant other, old age or other lack of livelihood. We believe our government's duty is to protect these basic human rights of safety, economic security, social equality, and cultural diversity. In the spirit of our founders we dedicate ourselves to the achievement of human dignity, liberty, and the pursuit of happiness.

#### **AGRICULTURE**

MISSION: We are committed to preservation of the family farm, agriculture-based jobs, and the marketing of diversified environmentally responsible products.

**SUPPORT** additional programs like **FEED the FUTURE** (<a href="http://www.feedthefuture.gov">http://www.feedthefuture.gov</a>) to combat domestic and world hunger.

**PROMOTE CROP DIVERSITY and ORGANIC FARMING**. Some of the existing subsidies shall be re-routed to farmers who grow oats, flax, rye, barley, pasture greens, root crops and various wheats. Other of these subsidies may be directed to smaller, organic (certified or not) farmers with one to forty acres. These subsidies shall be available to farmers who do not use pollutants (herbicides, fungicides, insecticides, glyphosate, nicotinoids) or other toxins.

**ELIMINATE MONOPOLY CONTROL of our nation's food processing industry.** 

**ENFORCE RUNOFF RESTRICTION** on commercial fertilizers and manure by mandating the use of filter strips and buffers of at least 20 feet from farmland along streams and rivers to help filter chemical runoff and prevent erosion.

**IMPROVE ENFORCEMENT** of the Packers and Stockyards Act, including legislative amendments and administrative rules that prohibit price discrimination by meatpackers against family farm livestock producers.

**CONTINUE** the **FARM BILL GRANTS** for non-profit and public organizations to develop gardens in low-income communities that are planted, cared for, and harvested by community gardeners, offering lessons on good production practices and diets to help provide

and supplement school lunches and donate to local food banks and senior centers, or be given to school children to take home to their families.

**PROMOTE** the "KNOW YOUR FARMER, KNOW YOUR FOOD" program for sustainable local and regional **food systems** that will support small and mid-sized farms and ranches, strengthen rural communities, promote healthy eating, and protect our natural resources.

# **CONFINED ANIMAL FEEDING OPERATIONS (CAFOs):**

**DEFINE** "FACTORY FARM" as a large institutionalized farm, a farm on which large numbers of animals are raised indoors in conditions intended to maximize production at minimal cost, with no grass or other vegetation in the confinement area during the growing season. Often animals are living in unsanitary conditions and are mutilated to avoid cannibalism and are fed large amounts of antibiotics and/or hormones to prevent disease and accelerate growth.

**ENABLE** counties to exercise local control to **SITE FACTORY FARMS**, including time for public comment and EPA input.

**ENACT STRICT REGULATION** of construction, maintenance and operation of CAFOs per State of Iowa standards. Issue permits for CAFOs only after the Iowa Department of Natural Resources (IDNR) has reviewed and found acceptable proposals regarding manure management, waterway and ground water effects, implementation of buffer and filter strips and effects of these operations on public health.

# MANDATE all CAFO owners and deed holders or investors to carry liability

**insurance** covering current and future public health issues that arise from their existence, as well as site cleanup resulting from any noncompliance or hazardous event. (This may affect producers who feed from 500 to over 5000 hogs.)

**ELIMINATE all SUBSIDIES** for the purchase and operations of CAFOs

**BASE PUBLIC POLICY** on **studies and research** to determine and limit the number of animals that can be kept in a given space in order to assure humane treatment of animals.

**REQUIRE frequent testing and inspections** for unsanitary/unsafe conditions, and require large farms and CAFOs to mitigate the stench and ground-water pollution caused by their operations.

**REQUIRE** food processing manufacturers and seed companies to **identify if GMO** (genetically modified organism) plants were used in their processing and to include that information in all labeling.

# CLIMATE PRESERVATION and ENVIRONMENTAL INTEGRITY / STEWARDSHIP

MISSION: We recognize that the earth's very survival depends on wise use of our resources, and time is short for us to make necessary changes in the way we manage them. We must turn to renewable sources of energy to ease and reverse the decline of our climate. We must protect our natural resources, preserve our cultural and historical heritage and sites, enhance outdoor recreational opportunities, and provide for the education and understanding of our citizens to enable them to become knowledgeable stewards of our environment.

We oppose construction of new oil pipelines in particular KEYSTONE XL and BAKKEN.

**Support continued** U.S. leadership in international efforts to combat climate change, including implementation of the Paris Climate Agreement.

AGGRESSIVE and IMMEDIATE work to slow and REVERSE CLIMATE DESTABILIZATION by lowering global warming pollution 80% below 1990 levels by 2050. This should be accomplished through regional and national cap-and-trade systems, with a tightening of the cap over time, in which 100% of credits are auctioned from the beginning and where government invests the auction revenues for the public good, such as by investing in clean, renewable energy technologies and energy efficiency measures.

**BAN FRACKING** in the State of Iowa due to the known dangers of poisoned water and increased risk of earthquakes (known as 'frackquakes'). In addition, we support a **statewide ban on mining sand for hydraulic fracturing** for natural gas or oil.

**PROVIDE FULL DISCLOSURE** of all current and new processes of energy refinement. **CREATE land management practices** in Iowa and across the country which minimize or prevent erosion of farmland and stream banks, and create sustainable habitats for aquatic life in

American waterways. **BAN OPEN LEAF BURNING** in urban Iowa, while allowing it in resource management such as burning of prairie and savanna. Expand leaf composting and mulching.

MANDATE REDUCTIONS on both state and federal levels in the amount of phosphorus and nitrates in our waterways.

**REINSTATE** numeric limits on mercury emissions.

**IMPROVE** and protect municipal water facilities in the provision of **sufficient**, **clean**, **available water** to all residents.

**SET A GOAL** of 50% from **renewable sources** for clean energy generated in Iowa by 2030, promoting solar, wind, geo-thermal and hydro energy technologies with tax incentives for businesses and rebates for users.

**ENDORSE** and **ENACT** international **CLIMATE PROTECTION** agreements. Specifically, the U.S. Government should negotiate limits on greenhouse gases with China and India in order to achieve a goal of 350 ppm of CO2 which would avoid the negative effects of climate change.

**ELIMINATE SUBSIDIES** for oil and nuclear energy.

 **INCREASE SUBSIDIES** for **renewable sources** of energy and alternative biofuels (switch grass, garbage, etc.) including the windmill tax credit which provides 7000 jobs in Iowa.

 **PRESERVE** all **cemeteries** and burial grounds of a sacred and historic nature. **PRESERVE unique land forms** such as Loess Hills, Prairies, and tAlgific Slopes.

 **OPPOSE** policies that lead to **destruction of wilderness areas** for oil, coal, and gas exploration and drilling.

**PROVIDE incentives for rehabilitation** or construction of public and private buildings that meet green building and efficiency standards.

**ESTABLISH** "**SMART GROWTH**" **policies** to contain and guide urban development in an environmentally responsible and socially equitable manner. This can be accomplished through infill development, coordinated residential, economic and transportation planning, land use and zoning policies in order to promote mixed-zone walkable neighborhoods conducive to mass transit, bicycling and walking, to reduce automobile dependence, increase community interaction, and create vibrant urban places.

INITIATE a federal program to REFOREST the compromised western forests.

**SUPPORT** dramatic reduction of corn ethanol while expanding production of non-food crop and non-forest crop ethanol.

FULLY FUND the Resource Enhancement and Protection (REAP) program (http://www.iowadnr.gov/Conservation/REAP)
INCREASE Department of Natural Resource (DNR) funding for state parks.
ENCOURAGE the City of Dubuque to fund a FULL TIME PARK RANGER for the
Mines of Spain recreation area.
SUPPORT educating people on the dangers of biomass burning.
SOLITORI educating people on the dangers of bioliass burning.
ECONOMY, COMMERCE, AND LABOR
MISSION: The American Dream has arisen on the arms and backs of our workers, and they
have been slighted in the workplace. We support the rights of workers to form unions and
bargain collectively, widen the scope of bargaining, share in the cost of representation (Fair
Share), and have patient "choice of doctor" when injured on the job. We further believe that
we must end tax advantages for companies that send jobs or corporate offices outside of U.S.
borders.
ENSURE that all of our trade agreements include labor and environmental standards,
and that ends the tax advantage for companies that outsource their factories, technology, or
financial operations.
REQUIRE U.S. based companies to comply with all U.S. regulations in their factories both
inside and outside of U.S. borders.
<b>AMEND</b> Chapter 731 and the pertinent parts of Chapter 20 of the Iowa Code to allow
private and public workers in Iowa to negotiate "fair-share" clauses to ensure that all workers
covered and benefiting from a negotiated contract would share in the cost of the service provided.
PASS the Employee Free Choice Act to protect the rights of both public and private sector
workers to form unions and bargain collectively.
MAINTAIN AND EXPAND the scope of bargaining for public sector employees.
SUPPORT a PREVAILING WAGE law for construction workers.
SUPPORT the right of workers injured on the job to CHOOSE their own medical care
PROVIDER.
INVEST in infrastructure.
RAISE the MINIMUM WAGE to \$12.50 an hour in 2017 and INDEX it for inflation.
CREATE a national "HIGH SPEED INTERNET for ALL" policy that preserves an open
Internet.
ELIMINATE PREDATORY LENDING by capping loan interest at 30% APR.
REQUIRE HEDGE FUND FEES management fees be treated as ORDINARY INCOME
and not capital gains.
ENFORCE legislation that compels WALL STREET AND THE 1% to pay their FAIR
SHARE.
SUSPEND the \$5.5 billion per year Postal Service PENSION PRE-FUNDING.

**URGE** the Legislature to provide IPERS adjustments for inflation and **COMMISSION** a task force to study the merits of creating an independent **BOARD OF TRUSTEES** to govern IPERS and to assume the fiduciary responsibility for the members of IPERS. The findings of this task force would be forwarded to the Governor and Legislature for consideration in the next legislative session.

**GROW** the AMERICAN ECONOMY through an increase in jobs related to alternative energies.

**EDUCATION**

233 (PANDAS) and Autism/Spectrum Disorders within the **INDIVIDUALS with**234 **DISABILITIES Act (IDEA)**.

**CLASSIFY INDIVIDUALS as INDEPENDENT** when no longer included in their parents' taxes, so they qualify **for financial aid** at institutions of higher learning, as it is becoming inaccessible to the middle class.

**AMEND** the school finance statutes for **AREA EDUCATON AGENCIES (AEAs)** and how they are impacted by across-the-board cuts. We encourage statutes to be changed so AEAs receive their entire state funding prior to an across-the-board cut.

**EXPAND JOB TRAINING** at Community Colleges, and coordinate with high school curricula for college and non-college track students.

**CREATE** and/or **EXPAND** no-cost or low-cost two-year **COMMUNITY COLLEGE** certified technical programs/associate degrees to all students maintaining a 2.5 or greater GPA.

**BROADEN USAGE** of the statewide sales tax from the current **infrastructure and property tax relief** to include school district general fund expenditures for the extraordinary transportation costs and other financial difficulties that many districts experience.

**CREATE** a statewide **PANEL** to oversee distribution of infrastructure money to local school districts similar to what was done for the Vision Iowa program.

**OPPOSE diverting** tax money from public schools to fund **VOUCHERS**, tuition tax credits, or private and/or for-profit education businesses.

**PAY** professional **SALARIES** for educators that are **in line with their levels of education** and increasing the wages of support professionals in our public schools in order to attract and retain the most qualified personnel.

**ALLOW EDUCATION SUPPORT PROFESSIONALS** (ESPs - school district employees in non-teaching positions) employed by public school districts to be eligible for unemployment benefits, as employees who are sub-contracted to do the same jobs as ESPs employed by schools are currently allowed to do.

SUPPORT every school employee receiving a competitive living wage and benefits.

CALL FOR academic presentation of philosophical, ethnic, cultural (including fine arts), and religious traditions in public schools to **better equip** our citizens with the social skills and understandings that are needed in our increasingly diverse communities. **IMPLEMENT** conflict resolution, civil discourse skills and coping skills training within current middle and high school curricula.

**REQUIRE** that the teachers, paraprofessionals, and staff in alternative public schools and juvenile facilities be **certified** and paid wages **commensurate** with public school teachers' wages. **REQUIRE** hiring **qualified librarians** in Iowa schools, and pay them a professional wage.

**KEEP** Iowa teacher's **COMPENSATION** above the national average to attract and retain highly qualified teachers and staff in the state of Iowa.

**CREATE** a comprehensive program to allow students to exchange community service such as through AmeriCorps and Community Foundation programs into **REDUCED** college tuition and/or student loans.

**APPROVE** Senator Warren's bill (S. 793) to: **LIMIT** percentage rates on student loans to 3.9% (slightly more for graduate students); **FIX** the Pell Grant program by increasing the maximum amount of Pell grants for low-income students and allowing use of Pell grants for Summer courses; **SIMPLIFY** the federal financial aid application process; and **LEVERAGE** federal dollars to give states incentive to increase public education investments.

**ALLOW** current and past students **to REFINANCE** existing student loans to new lower percentages.

**ADDRESS** the school –to-prison pipeline by revising zero-tolerance policies that automatically impose severe punishment regardless of circumstance and by focusing efforts on early intervention/prevention through the training and use of positive behavior supports for **AT-RISK STUDENTS** rather than punishment. Provide simple explanations of infractions and prescribed responses in the student code to ensure fairness. Create appropriate limits on the use of law enforcement within public schools.

IMPLEMENT and ENHANCE the IOWA SCHOOL SAFETY GUIDE. ENCOURAGE and INCENTIVISE DIVERSITY in local teacher hiring and recruitment.

INCLUDE and FUND SCIENCE, TECHNOLOGY, ENGINEERING, ARTS and MATH (STEAM) programs in elementary, middle, and high schools.

 **ENERGY** 

MISSION: We are committed to the promotion and implementation of sustainable and energy efficient technologies in rural and urban communities through education, training, workforce development, research and project facilitation.

**INCREASE** funding for research of alternative energy sources.

**CONTINUE or RE-ESTABLISH** tax credits and rebates for individuals/households and businesses for **energy-saving purchases**, such as Energy Star appliances and other significant energy-saving improvements.

**CONTINUALLY IMPROVE energy-efficiency** policies for utility companies, residential, commercial, and government buildings.

**ENACT** a **carbon tax** to fund research and development of renewable energy.

**AMEND** the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to **reduce emissions** of carbon dioxide by imposing a tax on primary fossil fuels based on their carbon content.

**BAN** the purchasing and use of **coal** by Iowa energy companies that is sourced from **mountain-top removal** practices.

**PLAN** for the eventual **closing** of all coal-fired powered plants.

**BASE DECISIONS** on public health, economic sustainability, environmental sustainability, and quality of life of local, state-wide, national, and global communities.

SUBSIDIZE research, development and production of non-carbon renewal energy sources.

**ENACT** ordinances allowing small cities to erect **city-owned turbines**.

**MANDATE net metering** for all utilities and rural electric co-ops, participation in energy saving programs and rebates, and **IMPLEMENT** reasonable feed in tariffs for private alternative energy generation stations.

**MOVE** our state and federal governments from an energy policy based on fossil fuels and nuclear energy toward one based on **renewable and clean sources** (solar, wind, tidal) and conservation, with the goal of reducing carbon in the atmosphere to under 350 parts per million (identified as the safe number by leading climatologists).

**DEVELOP** new manufacturing technologies, retrofitting buildings and factories, and rebuilding public infrastructure in order to **create new jobs**.

**LIMIT TAX INCENTIVES** for new construction of buildings to those that meet green **building standards** such as Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEEDS) certification.

**END** exportation of our country's own fuel.

**SCHEDULE** the systematic shutdown of existing **nuclear plants** and the delay of plans for the transportation of nuclear waste until the plans are proven safe for successive generations.

**SUSTAIN** the **EPA** as a fully functioning and fully funded governmental agency.

# **ENVIRONMENT**

MISSION: We believe that our local, state, and federal governments must aggressively address the environmental issues of our time: climate destabilization, dependence on fossil fuels, and the need to create sustainable economic systems and communities in order to ensure that our irreplaceable ecosystem supports future generations of life on this planet.

Promote energy efficiency through use of alternative sources (such as photovoltaic, wind, geothermal, bio-diesel and hydro energy technologies). We believe that funding for research and development is crucial.

MANDATE RECYCLING across the state of Iowa and our nation, including at all public buildings and events across Iowa.

**EXPAND** the Iowa beverage container deposit law to include non-carbonated bottles, and raise the deposit to 10 cents.

**FUND** public school education and public awareness campaign on ways to reduce individual and community environmental impacts, including a "Close the loop" campaign which encourages people to purchase recycled items.

# TRANSPORTATION --

INCREASE CORPORATE AVERAGE FUEL ECONOMY (CAFE) standards for all vehicles, including SUVs and pickups.

**IMPLEMENT** vehicle registration fees that reward **fuel efficiency**.

MANDATE minimum fuel efficiency for government-owned vehicles.

**PROMOTE** strong passenger and freight **train services** and the subsidizing of these services to an extent above what highways and airplanes are currently subsidized.

**FULLY FUND Amtrak** appropriations requests in the U.S. Congress and the expansion of mass transit on local, state, and national levels, with special attention given to the **restoration of** Amtrak passenger rail service between Dubuque and Chicago to benefit persons in our tri-state area.

REINSTATE federal funding for the High-Speed & Intercity Passenger Rail Program at a level commensurate with the importance of this vital transportation program in maintaining America's competitive edge in the global marketplace.

**CONTINUE** funding and construction of State Freeway 32 around Dubuque to **connect** Highways 61 and 20.

**BRING** all public transportation into **ADA** compliance.

**CREATE** and **FUND** a Human Trafficking Office within the Iowa Department of Public Safety to address the demand for sex slaves and labor slaves. **SUPPORT** involvement of health centers, law enforcement, human services, and schools to stop the supply of slaves through prevention and increased awareness.

**INCREASE** drug and mental health courts.

**REQUIRE** that the government post information on contracts online to **assure oversight** and an appeal process.

**CENSURE GOV. BRANSTAD** for closing Clarinda and Mt. Pleasant MHIs in violation of Iowa Code and without adequate alternate facilities in place

**REQUIRE open bidding** on government contracts over \$100,000.

**CONTINUE** Dubuque County's subsidy to Sunnycrest Manor nursing home. Ensure that any entity contracted by the Dubuque County Board of Supervisors to recommend efficiencies shall not benefit from those recommendations. Exclude consultants from being service providers.

**PROTECT** Freedom of the Press and **REQUIRE** media outlets, which refer to their programming as "news," to follow **strict journalistic integrity** guidelines such as those outlined by the Society of Professional Journalists (http://www.spj.org).

**BAN** Mandatory Minimum Sentences.

**SUPPORT** legislation requiring audio, visual, and surveillance devices such as dashboard cameras and body cameras to become universal law enforcement equipment. And implement compliance measures with severe consequences for law enforcement officials found to purposefully deactivate or disable devices.

**REQUIRE** transparency and **FULL DISCLOSURE** of contributions to elected officials.

**FUND** additional training for law enforcement agencies on appropriate techniques for detecting and interacting with people suffering from mental illness.

**FUND** additional training for law enforcement agencies on appropriate **non-lethal** intervention methods.

**PROHIBIT** the **privatization** of government provided education and health and human services.

**SUPPORT** the "**Justice is not for Sale Act** of 2015" (S2054) introducing criminal justice reforms and calling for an end to "bed quotas" for immigrants.

**REQUIRE** elected officials to implement technology that enables citizens to more easily **communicate** with officials (ie: Surveys) and increase **transparency** related to lobbying efforts, campaign contributions, and voting records.

**DEMAND** all US Senators do their **CONSTITUTIONALLY-MANDATED JOB** of advise and consent on federal court nominations regardless of when the nomination should arise. Doing nothing is not an option, and shall be cause for forfeiture of their seat in the senate due to malfeasance.

**END** practice of appointing Super Delegates, and **APPOINT** delegates based on the percentage of votes received in caucuses and by no other means.

**DECRIMINALIZE** marijuana.

HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICE S HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES MISSION: We believe human beings, our greatest

natural resource, are endowed with the capacity for growth and healing. A healthy society will support each person in achieving wellness and will benefit from contributions made by all. MISSION: We are committed to worldwide peace and sustainable prosperity. We will reach across diverse cultures, borders, and socio-economic systems to achieve fair trade and resolution of hostilities.

AFGHANISTAN and IRAQ -- Continue withdrawing our troops, advisors, private contractors and military bases from Afghanistan as quickly, safely, and responsibly as possible; and re-appropriate the saved funding partially to modernization of our armed forces and partly to deficit reduction. Partner with the world community under the leadership of the UN in efforts to restore war-damaged infrastructure. Require any long-term agreement with Afghan or Iraqi government be made with full and open Congressional knowledge and approval. Utilize all possible diplomacy with the many factions in Iraq and with neighboring countries of the Middle East to seek peaceful solutions to conflicts among the Iraqi people. Redirect our efforts and resources to combating sources of terrorism where they are concentrated along border between Pakistan and Afghanistan.

**IRAN** -- expansion of our **diplomatic relations** at the highest level possible, with a goal of encouraging Iran to **play a constructive role among its neighbors** in the Middle East.

**SYRIA and DA'AESH** -- US negotiate an end to US bombing, push for a regional embargo on all weapons from all sources, increase Syrian refugees to the US to between 100,000,and 200,000, provide humanitarian assistance to Syrians and border nations, and seek political solutions through multilateral negotiations inclusive of all parties

**AFRICA** -- diplomatic priority to **bring an end to all conflicts in Africa**, and contribute United States financial aid and diplomatic support to any peacekeeping mission in Africa.

**SUDAN** -- normalization of trade and travel relations

**CUBA** -- expand recent **normalization** of trade and travel relations.

# ISRAELI-PALESTINIAN CONFLICT --

Assure that the President and Congress make the **peaceful resolution** of the Israeli-Palestinian conflict a top priority, in coordination with the representatives of all nations as well as peoples in the region with a stake in the outcome, in **seeking a fair and just resolution** to the conflict.

Call on Israelis and Palestinians to end all acts of violence and join in good faith efforts to resolve their differences in the pursuit of a two-state solution.

Affirm the right of the Palestinians to a viable, contiguous state, comprised of land mass equivalent to the Palestinian's control in 1967.

Call for Ceasing of construction and orderly removal of Israeli settlements in the West Bank, the restoration of equitable water rights and the removal of the separation wall from Palestinian territories.

Call for Palestinians to affirm the right of Israel to exist within U.N. resolutions pertaining to its borders.

Ensure validity and sincerity of all negotiations, and hold both sides to strict compliance to any peace agreements.

**Support** the U.S. ending military aid to Israel, replacing it with both **humanitarian and economic aid** to Israelis and Palestinians.

**Oppose the continued collective punishment** of the non-combatant civilians of Gaza. **Support** full United Nations (UN) recognition of Palestine.

#### **DISARMAMENT -**

 **Renounce** development of **new nuclear weapons** and technologies, and secure international agreement by the year 2020 to cease all use of nuclear weapons.

Cease using landmines and cluster bombs in military situations and avoid selling these landmines and cluster weapons to other nations, but also we must join other nations in stopping their production and use, and participate in efforts to locate and deactivate landmines that pose a risk to civilians.

**Prohibit** development, production, stockpiling and use of all **chemical weapons**.

Sign and ratify conventions banning Uranium Weapons.

Cease use of Unmanned Aerial Vehicles (UAV) for military strikes.

# **HUMANE TREATMENT-**

**Adhere** to the **Geneva Convention** for the treatment of all prisoners, including "enemy combatants."

Close Guantanamo Bay prison as a move to bring our counter terrorism policies within the rule of law.

Oppose Trans-Pacific Partnership (TPP) and Transatlantic Trade and Investment Partnership (TTIP) because they are corporate 'wish lists' which attack environmental protections, affordable medication, and Internet freedoms.

**Oppose fast track voting process by Congress,** thus providing transparency in public debate.

**Oppose** any trade policy, which gives corporations impunity from government or citizens that want to reign in their power.

Cease all use of military contractors, and redirect funds currently expended on them, to strengthening ability of standing forces to take over tasks conducted by subcontractors, and to increase military pay across the board.

Reduce military budget and use savings in areas of human need.

# RESOURCE USE AND DISTRIBUTION / DEBT CANCELLATION --

Continually improve proportion of world's people with access to **safe drinking water**. We believe that all people have a right to life-sustaining amounts of affordable potable water. We support sustainable, clean, non-polluting water policies and publicly owned distribution systems.

**Support** more effective focusing of United States **development assistance**, including efforts to coordinate the United States development portfolio with other donors and host countries.

**Preserve** foreign assistance to people needing help with HIV/AIDS, clean water, agriculture and other **poverty-focused activities**, to become **self-sufficient**. Poverty-focused aid is only 0.6% (less than 1%) of the federal budget. In addition to helping permanently move people out of poverty, poverty-focused development builds markets for U.S, good and Services, and reduces the likelihood of violent conflict or war that may need significantly more costly interventions later.

**Support** 100% **debt cancellation** for all highly indebted poor countries and the promotion of long-lasting growth in poor countries by improving trade and investment opportunities.

**Require** President and Congress to **reduce global poverty** through international assistance that helps and empowers individuals through education, clean water, and elimination of HIV/AIDS, tuberculosis, and malaria.

**Oppose** reinstatement of the Mexico City Policy, also known as the **global gag rule.** International **NGOs** (Non-Government Organizations) should be free to promote sex education practices that **prevent the global spread of AIDS** and other sexually-transmitted diseases.

**SCHOOL of the AMERICAS** -- abolish School of the Americas (now referred to WHISC or Western Hemispheric Institute of Security Cooperation) and any other American-sponsored training for terrorists.

# UNITED NATIONS / INTERNATIONAL LAW --

Continue membership of the United States in the United Nations. Engagement with the UN provides a useful and efficient means for reconciling international issues and dealing with mutual concerns facing the global community including, but not limited to, the threat of worldwide terrorism.

Adhere to the United Nations "Universal Declaration of Human Rights."

Fully fund our obligations to support the United Nations by paying both dues in arrears, current dues, and peacekeeping costs.

**Commit** our nation to abide by and be **accountable to international law**, including all the Geneva Convention articles.

**Payment in full** of U.S. dues to United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO).

**TAXES** 

MISSION: For government to adequately serve people, it must raise revenue, and do so in an even-handed manner. All individuals should pay their fair share toward funding government services. Those who benefit the most economically from a strong and vital government should pay progressively more as their wealth increases. In recent decades the progressivity in taxes has been lost and the wealthy pay lower rates than everyone else, a type of class warfare that must cease.
